- Comparisons of Russian-speaking schools in Estonia to racial segregation sparking controversy;
- Concern for Russian speakers in schools.

### Overview:

This week, the posts mainly focused on Eurovision with the posters claiming that in order to win, the Estonian all-male group would be forced to act more feminine. There were also mentions about the economy, especially the taxes with a focus on the new car taxes and also the new voting law which will allow people to vote from their phones as well as their computers, which they claim gives companies such as Google and Apple more control of the elections.
